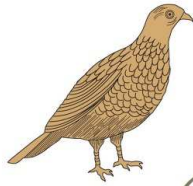

◆ [Nuits Saint Georges Premier Cru Aux Perdrix 2017](#)

92/100

Deep red. Flamboyant cherry nose. Rich and full-bodied, this is very concentrated and shows firm tannins. A robust style, as usual, with depth, structure, and force. Long, oaky finish.

◆ [Echezeaux Grand Cru 2017](#)

93/100

Deep red. The dense cherry and blueberry fruit on the nose dominates the new oak. The attack is firm, very concentrated and tannic. Spicy and gutsy, this isn't subtle but has energy and length.

◆ [Echezeaux Du Dessus Grand Cru 2017](#)

95/100

Although most of the domaine's Echezeaux vines are in this most privileged of the 11 *lieux-dits*, since 2016 it has bottled a barrel selection (two *pieces* in 2017) separately under this name. And while the regular bottling is very good, this is special : more *aérien* and intricate on the nose, more finesse and succulence on the palate. Superb
